I often see people who look like fashion models (I've been there, the photo studio is in Chuo Ward)

I didn't notice it much when I first moved here, but it seems like there are a lot of fashion models just a little east of where I live.

I've seen women over 175cm tall with good posture, men around 200cm tall, and white women.

I often see them at a drugstore where the majority of customers are women and where I frequent every day as a regular,

and they all walk east from there, so

In my many years living in Tokyo, I have never seen such a high proportion of them in Ebisu, so I can understand it as the same thing.

I remember realizing about a year after I moved here that JR Sapporo Station was just a short walk away.

By the way, even if you go to Ebisu or Akasaka, the chances of seeing a celebrity are virtually zero...
